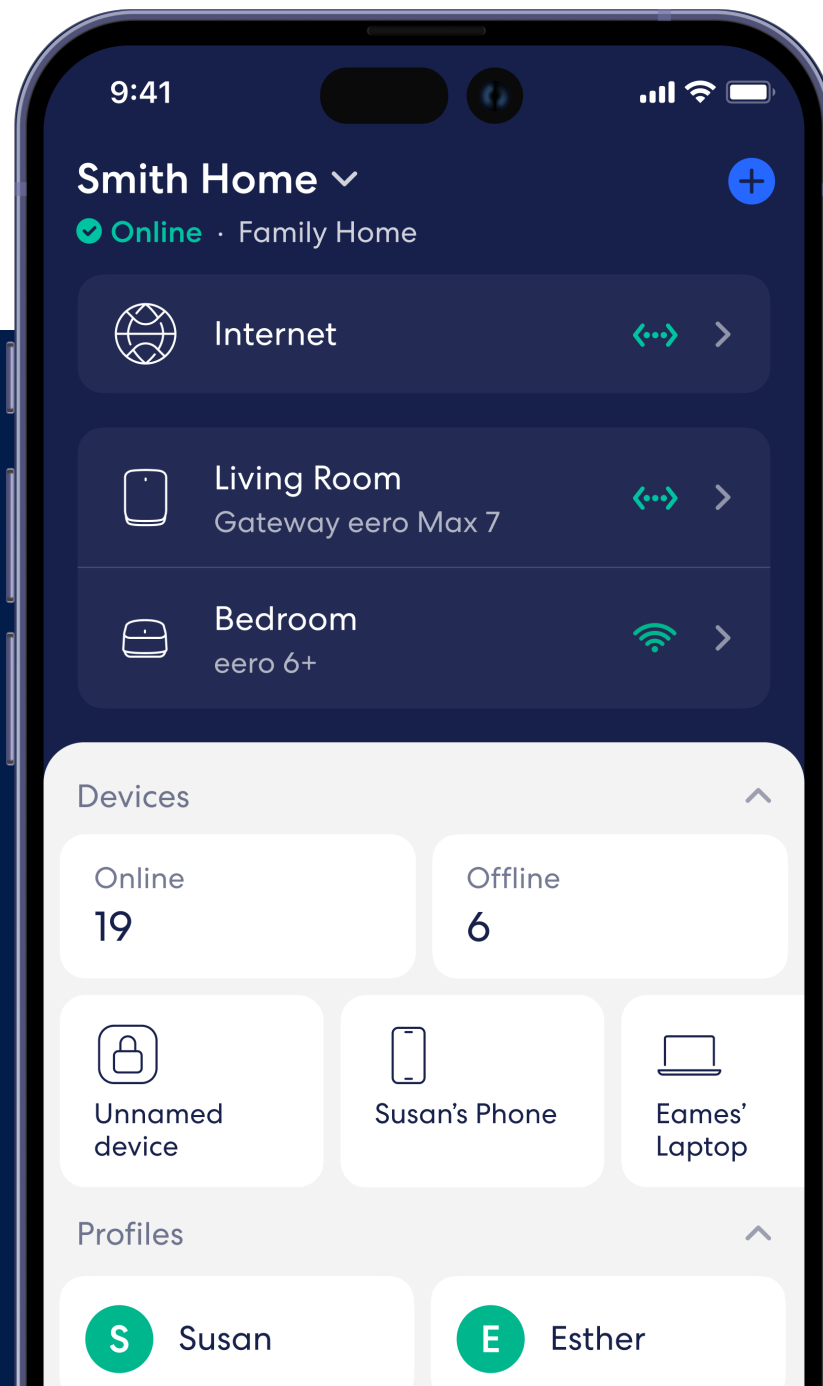

eero Secure adds security and safety services to your eero devices, such as active threat protection and advanced parental controls. It can also give you deeper insights into your network data usage and help improve your browsing experience.

Whether you’re setting up eero Secure for the first time or looking to do more, we’ve got you covered with the steps to set up and use eero Secure.

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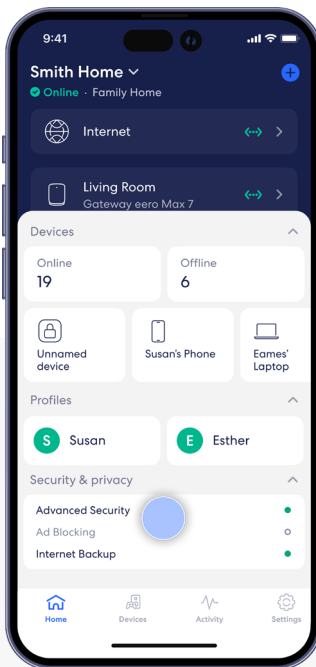


Note: Active Threat Protection is enabled by default for eero Secure.

Active Threat Protection

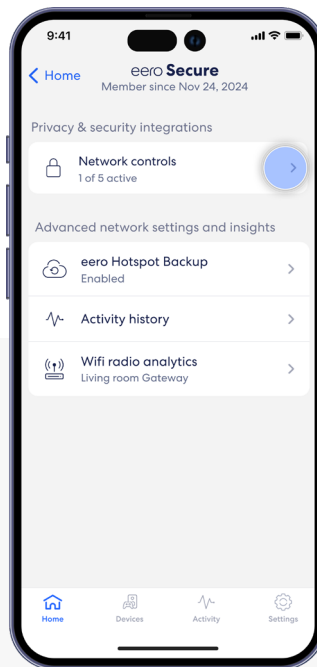
Automatically block access to malicious sites that can lead to phishing attempts, viruses, and advanced cyberattacks.

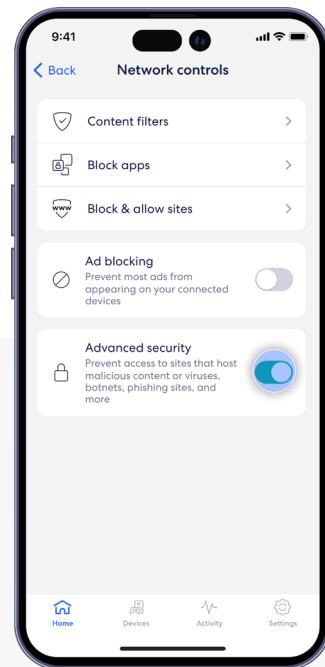
From the *Home* tab, tap on the module under *Security & Privacy* that says **Advanced Security**.

Toggle on **Advanced Security**.

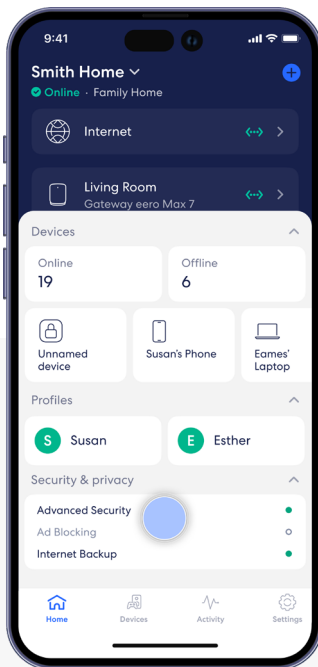


Ad Blocking

Remove inappropriate pop-ups, dangerous clickbait, and harmful ads to control what reaches your family online.

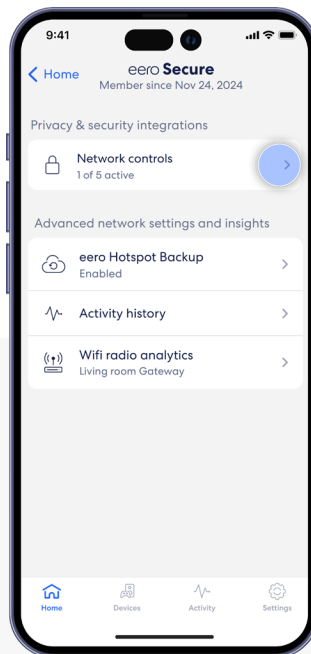
Turn on Ad Blocking from the homepage in your eero mobile app.

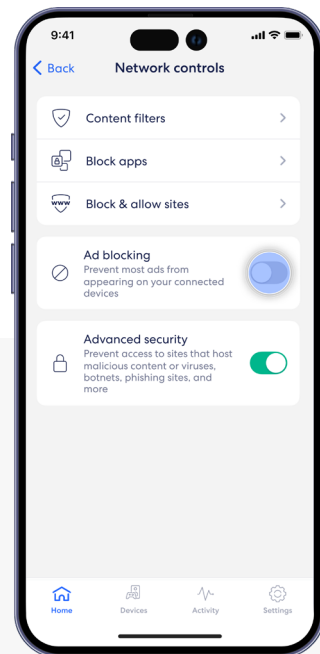
From the *Home* tab, tap on the module under *Security & Privacy* that says **Ad Blocking**.

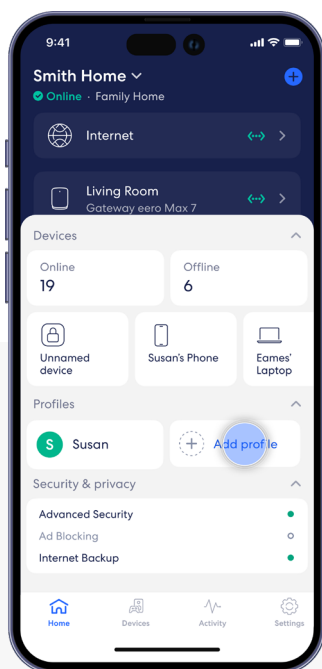


Profiles

Create profiles so that you can set custom schedules, control internet access, and apply Content Filters by profile.

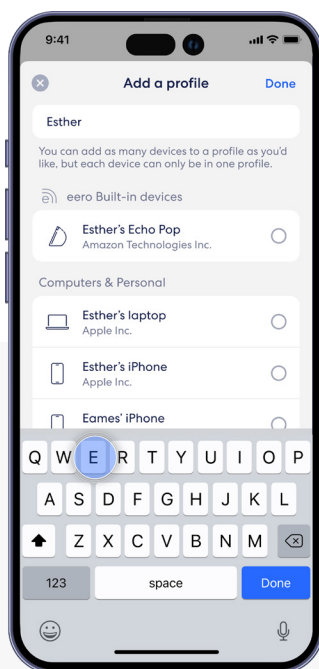
Create a profile from the Home tab in the eero mobile app.

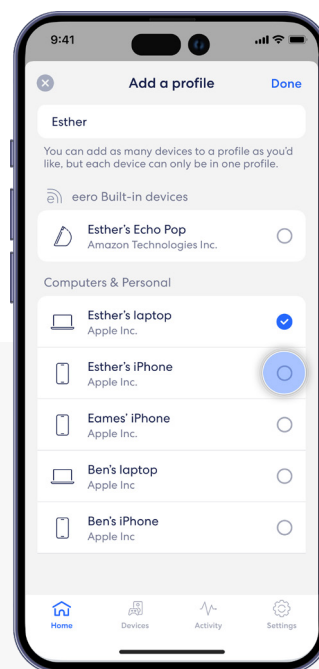
From the Home tab, tap on **Add a profile** in the Profiles section.

Select which devices to add to the profile.

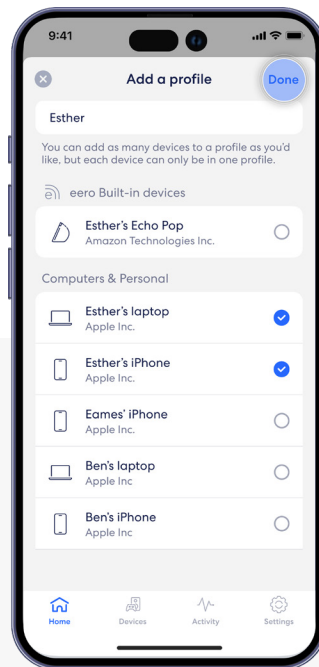

Hotspot Backup

Wirelessly connect your eero network to a backup hotspot to keep your wifi up and running even when your wired connection goes down.

Manage Internet Backup from the Home tab in the eero mobile app.



From the *Home* tab, tap on the module under *Security & Privacy* that says **Internet Backup**.



Tap on **eero Hotspot Backup**.



Toggle on **eero Hotspot Backup** to turn on.

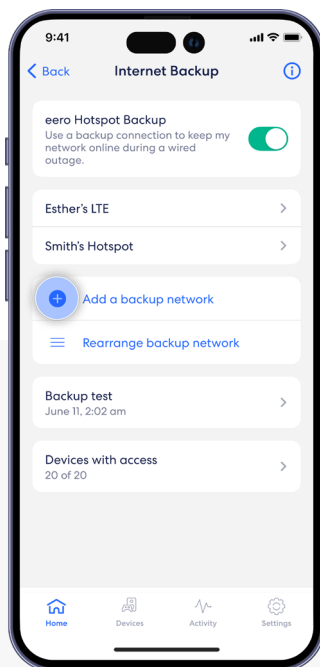


Hotspot Backup *(continued)*

Wirelessly connect your eero network to a backup hotspot to keep your wifi up and running even when your wired connection goes down.

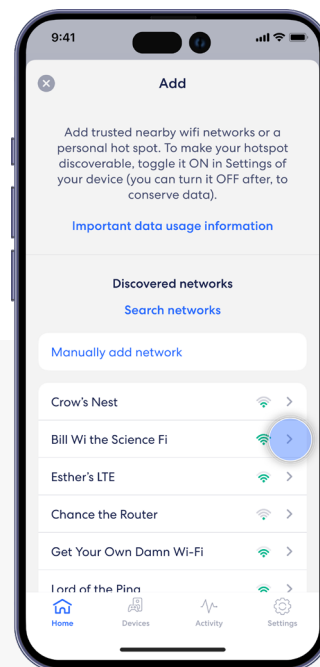
Manage Internet Backup from the Home tab in the eero mobile app.

Network Insights *(Data usage)*

View network activity, data use, security scans, and more from a single dashboard to quickly understand and adjust network settings and performance.

View data usage activity from the Activity tab in the eero mobile app.



From the *Activity* tab, tap on the **Downloaded Data** or **Uploaded Data** block.

Navigate between *Day*, *Week*, and *Month* tabs, and the *Profiles* and *Devices* tabs.

Select a profile or device to view more details.



Network Insights *(Threats blocked)*

View network activity, data use, security scans, and more from a single dashboard to quickly understand and adjust network settings and performance.

View data usage activity from the Activity tab in the eero mobile app.



From the *Activity* tab, tap on the **Scans** or **Threat Blocks** block.



Navigate between **Day**, **Week**, and **Month** tabs to view threat blocks over time.



Once done, tap on the blue arrow in the top left to go back.

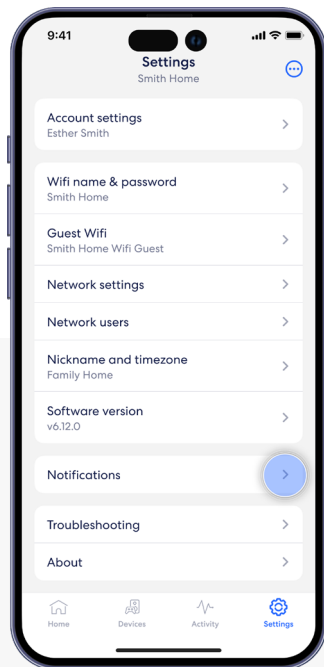


Notifications

Manage which eero Secure notifications you receive.

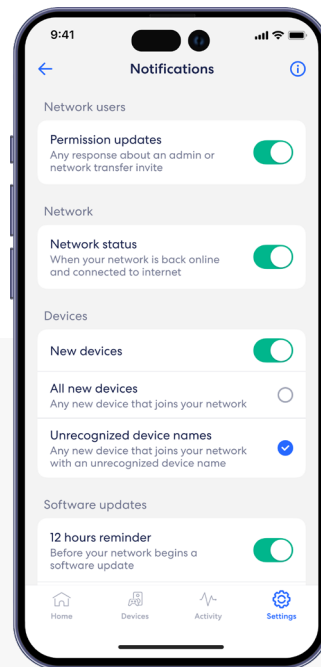
